

No, A 'Dog Year' Isn't Equivalent To 7 Human Years

Since smaller breeds tend to live longer than larger breeds, it's important to calculate your dog's age according to the right category; **small** (20 pounds or less), **medium** (21-50 pounds), **large** (51-

Dogs age at different rates compared to humans, but the simple rule of 7 dog years to 1 human year is far from accurate.

90 pounds), or **giant** (over 90 pounds).

If humans aged seven times slower than dogs, then many of us would be able to reproduce at age 7 and live to be 150. Obviously that's not the case.

The reason that dogs can reach full sexual maturity after only a year is that our canine friends age faster during the first two years of their lives than humans do.

Even this general statement is slightly off since smaller breeds tend to mature faster than larger breeds.

Compared to humans, dogs age more quickly at the beginning of their lives and slower toward the end. Therefore, calculating your dog's age relative to yours is a bit tricky, but luckily it's possible.

No, A 'Dog Year' Isn't Equivalent To 7 Human Years (cont'd)

Although the origins of the seven-year myth is unknown, people have been trying to find a good way to calculate dog years in human years since the 1200s. One of the earliest examples of this is an inscription at Westminster Abbey that dates to the year 1268 and calculates that one human year is equivalent to nine dog years, which was part of some strange way to calculate the <u>end of the world</u> in the 1200s.

The seven-year rule is thought to much more recent. A veterinarian at Kansas State University told <u>The Wall Street Journal</u>: "My guess is it was a marketing ploy. It was a way to encourage owners to bring in their pets at least once a year."

Big Dog Corner

If you own a Dane that is an "aggressive chewer" then you are in for some good news. I have found extremely durable toys that are made in the USA. I have tried many brands of "tough" toys and was disappointed that my dog was able to destroy it within an hour of playing with it. Not only is it expensive for my dog to chew up toys, but it is also dangerous if he were to ingest pieces of the toy.

The first brand I recommend is **Planet Dog's Orbee-Tuff** material toys. These toys are rated on a scale from 3-5

chompers. They have fun shapes that are large enough for Danes to enjoy. Orbee-Tuff is a plastic (thermo plastic elastomer) made without latex, phthalates or BPAs. A small amount of essential peppermint oil is added to give dogs fresh breath as they chew on the toy! These toys have been tested and shown to be non-toxic since Orbee-tuff was introduced 10 years ago. All Orbee-tuff toys are durable, bouncy,



buoyant, minty, and made in the USA. The toys that are rated 5 out of 5 chompers are extremely durable. They are primarily round in shape so the dog can't get an edge of the toy to the back of the jaw, where most of the hard-core chewing occurs. These particular rated toys are also hollow and pliable, which is pleasing to a dog that likes to squeeze and squish toys!



What else is awesome is that Planet Dog has a 100% satisfaction guarantee. The toys I personally recommend for Great Danes are the "Orbee Ball" (looks like Earth), "Artichoke" and "Eggplant" (both are in the produce section).

The second brand I would like to introduce is **West Paw Design's Zogoflex** material toys. This company is very eco-friendly and handcrafts 100% of their products in the USA. The toys they make are BPA and phthalate-free, non-toxic and complies with the FDA. This company as a whole relies on eco-friendly materials and hosts a "Join the Loop" toy recycling program, where any toy that is returned can be sanitized, grinded up, remolded and resold again.





There are 7 different toys to choose from, which come in 3 main colors; blue, lime green and orange (and sometimes black). These toys can be used to play tug, fetch and of course for chewing. These toys are buoyant and are great for taking to the pool or beach. They are easy to clean and are dishwasher safe.

West Paw Design's guarantee includes a one-time free replacement or refund of a destroyed/damaged toy. The toys I personally recommend are the "Tizzi", "Bumi", "Jive Ball" and "Hurley Bone". These have the option of either small or large size- obviously go with the larger sized toy!

I discovered these toys from a local store called "Unleashed" by Petco. After trying out and seeing these toys actually held up against my own dog, I had some luck finding more for cheaper on chewy.com and onlynaturalpet.com



*Note: It is always a good idea to pick up all toys that have the possibility of being destroyed and ingested if your dog will be left home alone. These toys mentioned above are indeed sturdy, but are by no means indestructible.

As always, use good judgment in the health and welfare of your big dog. Remember to consult your regular Veterinarian when you have questions and concerns!!
