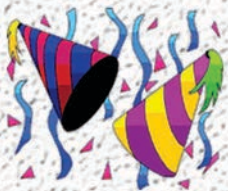

Major Poochie was what is called an “Over The Counter Stray” (which usually means dumped by owner calling it a stray so they do not have to pay a fee)

Major was micro chipped but the listed owner said he gave the dog away 6 months ago and did not want him.

Major had health issues of severe fleas, bleeding callouses, ectropion, anemic, tapeworm.

The call for help was put out to Facebook pages, a home in Northern California was willing to take Major but he needed to go into foster until a trip down South could be made for him. A vet tech from San Diego doing Belgian Malinois rescue agreed to get him out of the shelter take him to the vet and foster him. After a week with the vet tech the vet tech drove Major to Bakersfield where he was met by his Northern California new home.

Remington is a 3 year old black male , he was living in a car with his owner until he was rescued 3 months ago by a family living in an apartment and recently they had to get rid of him.

The Call For Help was put out on FaceBook pages, Legends Animal Rescue in Ramona, CA agreed to take Remington but there was no way to get him in Bakersfield. A call for help was put out to the FaceBook pages and asked people to donate to help pay the \$125. transport fee from Bakersfield to Van Nuys where he could wait for Legends Animal Rescue to come up for him. People donated to the transport and arrangements were put into action .
