Our Great Dane Community has lost a dear friend, an esteemed judge, and a true dog man, and we mourn his passing. Eric fought so valiantly for so many months following his most recent stroke and heart surgery, only to succumb to the Coronavirus in the end. He was a true warrior during this time, doing all he could to recover from all the difficulties he was facing. His bravery is certainly to be admired.

In thinking of all we have lost, I acknowledge his encyclopedic memory for everything Great Dane – from pedigrees to great dogs of the past, Eric was always willing to discuss and enlighten those who wished to learn. He not only loved the Breed but was also so enamored of the pioneers who brought Danes to the attention of the dog world. As a young boy he worked for Rose Roberts in her famous Dinro Kennels and continued to be active in the Breed through his college days where he graduated with a degree in English. His English degree influenced his interest in writing. Eric also enjoyed cooking, his specialty being Lemon chicken, which I can attest was wonderful.

Eric's friendships with many of the "greats" of our breed continued throughout his life. His expertise in handling the Danes in his charge was acknowledged by his clients and his peers. Eric was responsible for many of the AKC video standards during his employment there, including the one for Great Danes. He pursued his career as an AKC Judge with dedication, always continuing to study and learn about the new breeds under his review. I am so happy that he achieved the honor of judging at the Westminster Kennel Club, one of his many accomplishments.

My friendship with Eric has blessed me with so many wonderful, funny, and endearing memories. I will miss him in the years to come, as I know many of you will as well.




Cathy motioned to destroy the ballots – it was passed and they were destroyed.



Puppy Acne

Puppy acne is caused by the same thing that causes human acne, a combination of excess oily sebum and dead skin cells that clog pores or on a dog, clogged hair follicles. When mixed, produces inflammation and bacteria resulting in raised red lumps appearing mainly on lips, chin and muzzles. Lumps may be itchy and or painful to the touch.

There are numerous reasons why this may occur including genetic factors, hormonal changes, food and environmental allergies. Additionally, sometimes puppy acne can just be a normal part of adolescence which occurs between 5 to 8 months of age and disappear on its own by the time they reach 1 yr. old.

Great Danes are #2 on the list of most susceptible breed to develop puppy acne due to the short coat, and deep skin folds on muzzle.

Best way to prevent reoccurring puppy acne is by cleaning dogs muzzle with Witch Hazel astringent after meals to dry out deep skin folds under chin then apply benzoyl peroxide to the white heads not to the raised red lumps which could cause farther irritation. Silver Sulfadiazine would be a very soothing topical for the acne.

If acne is getting worse, please take your dog to a boarded Animal Dermatologist for additional treatment.
