#### SEPTEMBER OPEN MEETING MINUTES



#### GDCC General Open Meeting September 8, 2021

The meeting was called to order by the president at 5:34pm. The following board members were present - Jim Howey, Linda Tonnancour, Bruce Powell, Susie Powell, Robert Ardecky, Melanie Yellish, Maren Cornish, Tori Cornish, and Mike Rodriguez. The following club members were present – Bob Tonnancour, Maggie Foerschler, Hilary McLeod, Cathy Schaefer, Dick Schaefer, Rachel de la Vega, Debi Romerosa, Janet Lampe, Eleanor Powell. The following guests were present – Marion Phipps. The following board members were absent – Joy DeGruccio and Jessica Gibbs.

#### OFFICER REPORTS

**Recording Secretary's Report** – The board meeting minutes from July were accepted as published in the bulletin with no corrections. There was no further news to report.

Corresponding Secretary's Report –

#### Incoming Correspondence:

1. Received results of GDCC 2022 specialty judges' ballots.

#### Incoming & Outgoing Correspondence:

- 1. Nominations for GDCC 2022 Specialty Judges received forwarded for notification email to membership.
- 2. Forward second nomination list to be forwarded for notification emails to the membership.
- 3. Permission from GDCA to hold our 2022 Specialties.

#### **Outgoing Correspondence:**

- 1. Contacted elected judges.
- 2. Prepared and mailed contracts to the accepting judges.
- 3. Contacted Show secretary Cheryl Cazier to check on her availability for our 2022 specialty.
- 4. 2022 Specialty and Sweepstake Judge's contracts mailed to Jill Ferrera, Lourdes Carvajal, Cynthia Woodward, and Mike Boa.

*Treasurer's Report* – Linda reported the club financials for July and August, and had a separate breakdown for the specialties.

The bank balance at the end of June was \$9,610.15 The club received \$2,773.98 in interest (0.02) and for the 2021 specialty – catalogs (\$190), Food (\$675), Petty Cash (\$137), Raffle (\$1,359), Sweepstakes entry fees (\$90), Trophy (\$322.96). Disbursements totaled \$3,384.34 for the 2021 specialty – Food (\$536.72), Judges expense (\$1,023.62), Petty Cash (\$137.), Ribbons (\$1,064), Sweepstakes Prize money (\$63), Trophy (\$460) – and the park rental for the 2022 specialty (\$100). The bank balance at the end of July was \$8,999.79.

The bank balance at the beginning of the August was \$8,999.79. The club received a total of \$506.51 in August – interest (0.01) and specialty (food - \$150, raffle - \$185, superintendent -

\$171.50). The disbursements made in August were for the specialty – judges expense (\$664.96), raffle (\$719.92), trophies (\$400), and supported entry (\$47.79) – and totaled \$1,832.67. The club balance at the end of August was \$7,673.60.

The 2021 specialty had a total income of \$6,472.00 and the expenses were \$6,505.55. The income was from catalog ads (\$615), catalog sales (\$190), food (\$825), raffle (\$2,189.00), superintendent (\$171.50), Sweepstakes (\$90), and trophy donations (\$2,391.50). The expenses for the 2021 specialty were the AKC application fee (\$100), food (\$536.72), judge's expense (\$1,688.58), raffle expense (\$719.95), ribbons (\$1,264), sweepstakes (\$63), and trophy expenses (\$2,133.30).

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Specialty Report** – The 2021 specialties went great! Now onto the 2022 specialties! Judges so far are: Lourdes, Jill Ferrera, Cynthia Woodward, and Mike Boa. The following did not receive the needed quota and will be on the ballot coming out – Glen Lajeski, Eva Berg, Denise Dean, Nichole Bartlett, James Remaklus. A discussion was held regarding specialty expenses.

**Match Report** – Linda reported that the match will be held on April 16, 2021, on our traditional date. We also need to nominate and vote for the 2022 match judge.

**Bulletin Report** – Maggie reported that a correction to specialty show results will be in the next bulletin, and that the next bulletin will be another mini bulletin in September.

**Membership Report** – Tori reported that Marion Phipps and Sharon Johns are being published in the bulletin and will be voted on at the next club meeting, and Judy Landers has attended one meeting and will attend a second open meeting when she is next available.

**Facebook Report** – Gary said that changes may need to be made on the GDCC Facebook page, but that it is all settled to go forward.

**Pet Expo** – This event is not happening this year due to Covid precautions.

**Holiday Party Report** – The awards party will take place on December 11, 2021, in Placentia at Alta Vista Country Club. Linda and Maren will share the brunch menu options when they are made available to them.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

Melanie informed the club that we had Charitable Trust tickets available for the rainbow pendant necklace. The club agreed to purchase the remaining 8 tickets for \$5 each. Maren asked about the required number of get for Producers of Merit. It was discussed that to anyone's knowledge the number has not been lowered.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Linda reserved 10 motorhome spots in the park for the specialties in May as close to the ring as she could. Reserving 10 spots or more makes it \$50 a night for hook ups, under 10 would be \$75 a night for full hookups. The club approved her reserving the 10 spots. The meeting was adjourned at 6:34pm.

The next meeting (a closed meeting and a board meeting) will be via Zoom on November 10. Ballots for voting at the November meeting will be sent out by email the day before so that they can be submitted by the meeting time. We will be voting on new members and the new slate. If the slate runs unopposed, there is no vote taken and the slate is approved as published – as per the parent club's recent vote and rulings. Cathy brought up that for voting on new members at the meeting, if the voting occurs ahead of the meeting, there should be a short statement by sponsors on their relationship with the nominee published. The written statements will accompany the ballots ahead of the meeting. One or both of the new member's sponsors still has/ have to be present at the meeting to speak on their relationship with the nominee.

- EVERY <u>INDIVIDUAL</u> CLUB MEMBER WHO IS THE OWNER/CO-OWNER OR BREEDER-CO-BREEDER OF A DOG EARNING AN AWARD MUST INDIVIDUALLY APPLY FOR THEIR AWARD TO THE AWARDS CO-CHAIRPERSON OR <u>NO AWARD FOR THAT INDI-</u>VIDUAL WILL BE GIVEN.
- Family members must apply/request individually, regardless of ownership or breeder status.
- No awards will be given to non-club members, regardless of ownership or breeder status.

# Great Dane Club of California Awards 2021

All awards must have been earned during the club awards year except for membership mementos. **Beginning date for the year 2021 is November 10, 2020 through November 8, 2021.** You may elect to send an 8 x 10 show photograph of your dog to the Awards Chairman as well. This photo will be retained by the Historian in the club's records. Photos will not be returned. **If your dog earned his award BEFORE you became a club member no award will be given.** 

#### SUBMITTAL DEADLINE FOR AWARDS IS NOVEMBER 10, 2021 AT 6:00 P.M.

**TOP GREAT DANE AWARD: BOB wins only.** 1 point for each great dane entry present. These points are to be won in California shows only. (11/80)

**TOP DOG AWARD:** BOB wins - 1 point for each great dane entry present or BOS wins - 1 point for each DOG entry present. California shows only. (1/92)

**TOP BITCH AWARD:** BOB wins - 1 point for each great dane entry present or BOS win - 1 point for each BITCH entry present. California shows only. (1/92)

**TOP GREAT DANE AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLER AWARD**: Given to top-ranked Owner Handler Team participating and following the NOHS rules. Same Owner-Handler Team must earn all points (including class competition/breed ring). AKC NOHS ranked California shows only. (8/18)

The intention of the last two awards is to honor the most consistently winning club member owned/co-owned great dane dog and bitch in California. Club award boundaries include all of California.

**TOP BREEDER AWARD:** Awarded annually if earned. Given to club member who is the breeder/co-breeder of the greatest number of great danes to attain championship title during the club award year. Minimum of three champions required. (1/01)

**TOP STUD DOG AWARD:** Awarded annually if earned. Given to the club member who is the owner/co-owner of the great dane dog producing the most championship titled danes during the club awards year. Minimum of three champions required. (1/01)

TOP BROOD BITCH AWARD: Awarded annually if earned. Given to the club member who is the owner/co-owner of the great dane bitch producing the most championship titled danes during the club awards year. Minimum of three champions required. (1/01)

BEST IN SHOW OWNER AWARD: Given to any club member owned/co-owned great dane winning a BIS at an all-breed show anywhere in the world. (1/92)

BEST IN SHOW AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLER AWARD: Given to any club member who participates in the AKC NOHS program who owns and showed a Great Dane winning BIS NOHS at an all-breed show. (8/18)

CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS: Given to all members who own/co-owned a great dane who has attained its AKC championship title.

OWNER OF SIRE CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS: Given to all members who own/co-own a sire of a great dane who has attained its AKC championship title. Member must own/co-own the sire at the time of breeding.

BREEDER OF CHAMPION AWARDS: Given to all members who bred/co-bred a great dane who has attained its AKC championship title.

GRAND CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS: Given to all members who own/co-owned a great dane who has attained any one of the levels of the AKC Grand Championship titles (9/12):

Initial GCH	25-99 GCH Points

Bronze GCH 100-199 GCH points

Silver GCH 200-399 GCH Points

Gold GCH 400-799 GCH Points

Platinum GCH 800+ GCH Points

OWNER HANDLER AWARD: Given to any club member who handled has or her own great dane to all 15 championship points. (1/92)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR AWARD: Given to any club member owned/co-owned great dane finished entirely from the Bred By class. (1/92)

PERFORMANCE: Given to any club member who owns/co-owns a Great Dane who has earned a title/degree or certificate in any of the disciplines which shall include, but not be limited to obedience, agility, rally, flyball, dock diving, barn hunting, coursing agility, canine good citizenship, therapy and other service/performance-based activities awarded by certified organizations. Must be earned within the designated dates for the current awards year. Documentation must include certificates from the respective certified organizations. (6/15)

SILVER WORKING DOG AWARD: Given to any club member who owns/ co-owns a Great Dane who has earned a least 1 title/degree or certificate in each of (2) above disciplines. No timeframe is required to submit foe this award, with the exception that the most recent title must be earned within the current awards year. Documentation must include certificates from the respective certified organizations. (6/15)

GOLD WORKING DOG AWARD: Given to any club member who owns/ co-owns a Great Dane who has earned a least 1 title/degree or certificate in each of (3) above disciplines. No timeframe is required to submit foe this award, with the exception that the most recent title must be earned within the current awards year. Documentation must include certificates from the respective certified organizations. (6/15)

VERSATILITY AWARD: Given to any club member who owns/co-owns a Great Dane who is an AKC Champion of Record (confirmation) who has earned a least 1 title/degree or certificate in each of (3) above disciplines. No timeframe is required to submit foe this award, with the exception that the most recent title must be earned within the current awards year. Documentation must include certificates from the respective certified organizations. (6/15)

"THE TOTAL PACKAGE" AWARDS - BROOD BITCH & STUD DOG: To reward breeding programs that focus on promoting breed health (physical health as well as temperament), danes eligible for this Award must be AKC Champions of record. The focus of this award is on brood bitches, as we acknowledge that breeding programs are largely controlled by the bitch owners. (9/09)

#### **BROOD BITCH AWARD**

SILVER Star Breeder: Any 2 recognized health checks on a public database (e.g., OFA, CERF), and any recognized basic temperament certification (e.g., AKC Puppy Star, CGC)

GOLD Star Breeder: CHIC certification on OFA database (with all CHIC tests passing), OFA testing for heart (echocardiogram), eyes (CERF), thyroid (MSU), and hips (HD); CGC or other basic temperament certification, and any AKC sanctioned performance title.

PLATINUM Star Breeder: A CHIC certification (with all CHIC tests passing), four health checks completed and published in OFA database; Thyroid, Heart and CERF done on an annual basis (or within 12 months of breeding). Any two or more advanced AKC sanctioned temperament and/or performance titles.

#### STUD DOG AWARD

This award encourages stud dog owners to take responsibility in collaboration with the breeder to promote healthy litters. It is recommended that stud dog owners include the following in their stud contracts:

Stud dog owner encouraged to provide proof of passing one or more temperament tests (AKC Puppy Star, TT, CGC, TDI, or any AKC sanctioned performance titles.

Stud dog to have a least a CHIC certification (passing all CHIC required tests) and all health tests repeated within 12 months of breeding.

Encourage bitch owners to health check offspring that are pet quality as well as show potential.

Encourage bitch owners to sell puppies not kept for their own breeding programs on limited registration, which can be lifted upon written acceptance of both breeder and stud dog owner (and based on passing temperament tests and health checks).

Encourage bitch owners to provide contact information to stud dog owner for all puppies in litter, so that the stud dog owner can monitor health of offspring.

KAY KINOSITA AWARD: Honors a member who has given outstanding service to the club or the breed. Recommendations must be received in writing by the President at least one week prior to the November Board meeting. The Board of Directors votes on the names submitted to them before the November Board meeting. Discussions and voting will be done via the social media that proves the most efficient for the existing Board of Directors. (9/17)

OUTSTANDING NEW MEMBER AWARD: Honors a new club member(s) that has been a member less than one full year for outstanding service to the club. Recommendations are reviewed and approved by the board. Contact Awards Chairman for full details. (11/01)

VENERABLE GREAT DANE AWARD: Given to any member who owned/co-owned or bred/co-bred a Great Dane who is 10 years of age or older. Awarded once during the life of the dog. Reasonable proof required. (9/15).

MEMBERSHIP MEMENTOES: Given to any member to recognize 10, 25 and 50 years of club membership. This is an ongoing award and may be applied for at any time once earned. Please provide date of membership. (11/01)

#### YOU MUST BE A MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING TO RECEIVE ANY AWARD. (11/80)

Any club member may elect not to receive plaques for awards earned during the year. In place of said plaques an amount equal to the cost of the plaques will be set aside for donation to a great dane health and/or welfare program or organization of the club's choice. Club members electing this option must inform the Awards Chairman in writing at the time they apply for the awards. The names of the dogs and their awards will still be read aloud at the annual awards dinner. (1/01)



### The all-important Recall

Three easy rules to remember

#### Come Command

Your "come" command should always be an upbeat tone of voice and word such as "Here", even when in a panic, so the dog will not be afraid to come to you. If the dog is running around and ignor-

ing you, kneel down and open arms wide to welcome the dog to you. When the dog comes give lots of praise even if you are furious, the dog needs positive reinforcement to know when called it is a safe place to come to. Next snap a leash onto the collar and encourage the dog to walk with you. Do not grab the dog by the collar this will only provoke the dog to pull away.

#### Training Reliability

Find what motivates your dog to respond to your commands; Favorite toy, treat, verbal praise by you or a good old fashion human physical touch.



#### Repetition is Key

Remember it takes about a month for a behavior to be conditioned to the point of an automatic response.

Reinforcement of recall should be used on a daily basis with and without distractions and made fun for the dog as if it is a game.

Having a strong recall has been a lifesaver for me when walking my dogs off leash. After we mastered the "Here" command I switched to a whistle noise with my mouth to recollect my dog. I have found this to be an easy tool, one I don't leave at home, and I don't sound like a crazy lady calling my dogs. My dogs also wear a training collar which has a bell sound I will use when they blow me off and they will respond to that noise. Whatever I do use I do not over use the word or noise and I am always paying attention to our surroundings.

The freedom to walk my dogs off leash with confidence is an amazing feeling!!
